With the "Eyes of the Heart"

Giovanna Gould portrays people. Her drawings are produced mainly in public places, at railway stations or in the courtroom. She draws skilfully and quickly. On average she only needs 10 minutes in which to produce a sketch. Hundreds of sketches of different people have consequently been created over the last few years in Vaduz, Buchs or during the course of her many travels. Most of these depict people waiting, with whom the artist creates a subtle relationship as she captures them in her pictures. "In these works of art there lies a deep humanity on part of the artist (to accept others as they are, how they express themselves and getting as close to them as possible without being intrusive). Gould possesses great skill of unpretentious and understated drawing able to capture the intrinsic value of each person and surroundings in the moment and situation." (Peter Stobbe, June 2011, Kunsthochschule Liechtenstein.) Her drawings make up a mosaic which gently but insistently stands against our transient and impersonal world.

Giovanna Gould completed a four-year Master of Arts in painting, stage design and art history at the Academy of Fine Arts in Florence. Subsequently she studied languages at the University of Florence. Later she taught languages and art in places like Italy, the Seychelles, Zimbabwe, the Caribbean and Liechtenstein.

In the 60's and 70's Gould's works were mainly large-scale oil paintings which were displayed in several single or group exhibitions. Lately she has exhibited in Florence, Kosovo, Liechtenstein, Uruguay, Switzerland and the Cape Verde Islands.
