Global Art 2000 is moving at a rapid pace and needs to spread its message throughout the world quickly. The World Federation of United Nations Associations and NUbreed Synergy of the Arts, both non-profit organizations with a 501(c)(3) status, have joined forces to organize *the most culturally diverse art exhibition tour in history*. All one hundred eighty-five UN member states are invited to nominate three of their local living artists perceived as *Art Masters of the Third Millennium*. A committee of jurors is being formed of eminent art curators, critics and other art influentials internationally to select one out of the three artists nominated to represent each country.

To launch the tour, GLOBAL ART 2000, a premiere gala opening reception will be held at the United Nations in New York City, January of 2000. After the premiere gala, the exhibit will open to the public for several months before it embarks on a two-year national tour. Several member states have expressed interest in hosting and touring the exhibition outside of the United States. GLOBAL ART 2000 will unite artists from diverse cultures through a common bond of unconditional imagination, talent and a sheer love of life, encouraging optimism and global unification to all as essential components of the third millennium.

1. Nomination of three artists considered to be the masters of the third millennium in visual arts (painting, sculpture, illustration, and decorative art). Artists must be native citizens of your country.

2. Deadline

NOVEMBER 15TH, 1998 - Your written confirmation of participation in GLOBAL ART 2000 must be received.

JANUARY 31ST, 1999 - Deadline for nominations. Applications and all requested materials must be sent to:

MARCH 31ST, 1999 - Selection will be completed. One artist will be selected out of the three nominated to represent each member state by a distinguished panel of jurors.

Exhibit is scheduled to premiere at the United Nations
the first quarter of the year 2000.
(Date to be announced September 1999)

3. Sponsor artists' travel and accommodations to attend launch in New York City (optional)
4. Sponsor freight of art to and from the United States
5. Inform your country's local media of the project and distribute press releases
6. Supply a quote from: President, Prime Minister, Ambassador, or other prominent spokesperson on the mission of GLOBAL ART 2000 for press kits, public relations efforts and presentation books
7. Supply a brief history and visuals of the evolvement of art within your country to be featured in various materials and presentation books throughout the tour (Maximum one-page write-up and two visuals in slide or photography form.)
