Liechtenstein artist Elisabeth Büchel to showcase her work at the Circle Point Artspace in Washington beginning November 7, 2003

CONNECTIONS – EARTH AND SKY – CANVAS AND COLOR

WASHINGTON, DC – Elisabeth Büchel will be featuring a collection of her work in Washington, which will be on display and for sale at the Circle Point Artspace beginning November 7, 2003 and will be on exhibit until December 12, 2003. The exhibition entitled Connections – Earth and Sky – Canvas and Color is sponsored in part by the Embassy of The Principality of Liechtenstein.

The exhibition will be featuring <u>Elisabeth</u> Büchel's exploration of <u>questions and contents</u> which capture her interest as a painter and as a human being. She works on visual solutions through painting. Abstract geometric compositions, "imprecise" areas, transparent layers of paint, subtle tones of color, uneven lines drawn by hand, are her means of expression. Elisabeth Büchel develops a new aesthetic on a large expanse and her oeuvre shows the almost limitless possibilities contained in the reduction to pure painterly elements, such as color, shape and surface....?

Elisabeth Büchel was born in Mauren, Liechtenstein in 1954. While attending college in the U.S, Büchel was able to cultivate her artistic talent resulting in a style that mixes American expressionism and European modern art.
